Presidents Report - Ben Munro

It is hard to fathom that it has again come time to prepare my report paying tribute to and reflecting upon the 2016/2017 season. It may be the period of growth and frenetic activity we are experiencing as a Club (or it may just be this President's age), but each season these days seems to fly by quicker than the last. It was, however, a season to remember! As a barrister, I am usually better with words but I think the best way to describe our successes this year is by the numbers.

This year we assisted our members to achieve a record number of awards - 1,613 Awards in season 2016/2017 in total. Fifty Four new Bronze Medallion holders joined the Lifesaving family this season and Twenty Seven new SRC Award Holders qualified ready to tackle their Bronze in the coming season. We proudly boasted 962 SLSC Members including 290 Active Members. 7,677.25 volunteer patrol hours were completed by our patrolling members, contributed to by 308 qualified volunteer Surf Lifesavers. And of course the number which means to much more to me than any other - there were again Zero preventable deaths at our beach in the 2016/2017 season.

We were proud to support our members' ongoing involvement in the PDB Team X-Treme Program and various Youth Development activities and camps facilitated by SLSQ as well as our internal activities designed to foster club spirit, build culture and support both the development and enjoyment of our young members in lifesaving activities.

It was a competitive season to remember. We achieved second at the Rescue 2016 World Lifesaving Championships - the Club's best ever result. We boasted two World Champion Teams and one Individual World Champion. The Club achieved Second at the 2017 Australian Surf Life Saving Championships for the second year running. We retained the 2016 Australian Pool Rescue Championships Point score championship. We assisted five athletes to compete in the Kellogg's Nutri Grain Iron Series, another Club record. The Club had four members selected to represent International Teams - Australia and NZ at Rescue 2016. Our IRB Racing Team is back and building into a very competitive unit.

It was another very successful year for the Supporters Association with very solid trading figures being posted despite some significant weather challenges being thrown our way. This season was a period of consolidation, as the Club prepares to undertake a major renovation to ensure the facilities continue to attract record crowds to our unique location. Facilities aside, our shining asset was again our staff who deliver such incredible hospitality day in and day out. I take this opportunity to extend my sincere thanks to the Supporters Association Committee for their foresight and commitment to improvement but also to our incredibly talented team, led by the incomparable Chris Kelly as General Manager – also his wonderful second in charge Murray Turnbull, all of the Duty Managers, the bar staff, the restaurant staff, the front of house, the administration and marketing team and of course the engine that drives it all under the most unbelievably difficult pressures, the team in the kitchen! Thank you for ongoing support and hard work which allows the SLSC to expand its operations and continue to grow and achieve its strategic goals. More than that, thank you for the warm way in which you look after our Surf Club members throughout the year.

This season saw the successful integration of Nippers back into the SLSC structure. We are finally one Club from top to bottom and not before time! We had 299 Nippers registered this season. These dynamos were PDB Champions and Gold Coast City Titles Champions in season 2016/2017 and achieved a very credible fourth at the State Titles. In fact, they went into the last day of competition still hanging on to first place on the point score but were overrun in the end. To Ben Cahill and the junior committee, I am indebted to you for all the hard work that you have put in and for reminding us all how much fun you can have whilst volunteering. To watch the pride that these people instill in our little lifesavers about being a Viking and wearing the green and white is inspirational. It can never start too young.

The Active Member Night function attendance was well up on previous seasons and a great cross section of members from Life Members to new Club Members and Nipper families all descended on the Club each month, assisting us to realise our goal of bringing the diverse sections of our Club together under one banner. I am indebted to the Social Committee who worked tirelessly to facilitate and promote social activities including the Season Launch, Sportsman's Lunch, Annual Dinners, Active Member Nights, post-event celebrations, Youth Balls and Women in Surf functions. It has never been truer to recognise that "The Club That Parties Together, Stays Together".

From my point of view, I would like to thank all of those members who assisted on the Club Council, the Management Committee, subcommittees and all members who did all of those little things which perhaps go unnoticed. I noticed. Thank you. I wish to thank the Club's quiet achiever, Carole Walle for the countless tasks she simply "handles" in her wonderfully quiet and unassuming way. So many parts of our Season ran smoothly because of Carole's talents including, of course, the burgeoning Proficiency days.

And finally, could I pay my deep and heartfelt thanks to our brilliant CEO, Michael Sullivan. If I may conceitedly claim one achievement – indeed probably my only achievement as President - it is to have moved heaven and earth to ensure that not only do we retain Michael Sullivan's services, but that his genius and foresight is allowed to flourish and grow. 



Surf Sports~ Marsha Maynard

This season saw our Surf Sports group of Boats, Beach, IRB, Surfing and Water competitors shine brightly once more. We welcomed new members in every section this year and they have become part of our big family. We competed in all disciplines of surf sports starting the season with the Coolangatta Gold. We entered several teams and three individual males this season. Our Short course Male Team and Long Course Male Team came away with victories and we had two open men finish in the top fifteen

We travelled all over the globe this year including attending the World Titles in the Netherlands. We took 20 Open competitors consisting of ten males and ten females and a female Boat crew. The Hunters Boat crew started the medal count winning the female Boat race. The Medal tally of eleven in total placed us second in the interclub overall point score. We had some great individual and team results. What an achievement in our first major assault with a full team on the world stage. (It must be noted we have attended other World Titles but not with a full twenty competitor team)

They like to go fast and with Werner and Luke leading by example the little IRB competitive crew are moving forward very fast. They attended all the carnivals over the season making semis and finals always standing tall in the Green and White. And at the State titles this small group placed fourteenth overall.

Pool Rescue is gaining momentum. This season the Club won the Branch titles, finished second in State Titles and won the Australian Titles. Their season is a small window compared to the six month training period of the other sections. Most of the competitors come straight from Australian Surf Titles into the Pool Rescue season. It is inspiring how talented these pool swimmers are.

The club has grown again this year and the Boat section raced over fourteen crews in various events throughout the season. The Boats competed in the Ocean Thunder series, QLD Cup and the Navy Series. Ocean Thunder had four teams entered and the Barbarians came home second place. The Navy series had most of the crews participating in at least one carnival always showing strong placing throughout the series. The State titles were the last competitive racing for the Boat crews and they destroyed the fields in most divisions. Open Men first, third and fourth. U23 female third U23 male first, U19 male first and Reserves third. Awesome results.

The Water arena increased slightly this season making up some commanding teams. Our younger age groups are expanding with these competitors hungry to step into open arena in the near future. Youth Aussies was completed for the under 14's and 15's and this limited entry event is one of the hardest contested at any Aussies event. The kids stood tall and brought home three medals over the two day format. Well done. A relatively new growing carnival format, Summer Of Surf Series showcased teams and individuals on Fox Sports TV throughout the year. The Open and 19 age groups travelled up and down the East coast following the series. The Nutrigrain Series highlighted the Ironmen and Women and CBV had five strong competitors showcasing the Green and White. Karlee Nurthen Placed third overall in the women's final standings. The Aussies was a wash out for most of the Water events, they had one-day of competition in which we watched the Vikings bring home five open medals and two under 19 medals. A total of 7 medals in one day, awesome work.

At Currumbin Beach we are lucky to have a home surfing break which payed off when it came to showing how strong we are in Board Riding. At the QLD state titles the little CBV team place second overall with some outstanding results. The Board Riding was completed at the Australian Titles this year before the whole event was cancelled and achieved amazing results. They came away with 9 medals in total. Three quarters of these competitors backed up and raced in others sections at Aussies and State Titles! Well-deserved results.

The mighty Sand Crabs "beachies" ran dominantly all season! "The fastest Man on Sand" and the "Summer of Surf series" gave the large crew a hit out before they launched themselves on the Aussies at Kirra. The Beach arena was another section that completed the Aussies this year. They came away with eleven medals in total. It was spine tingling watching the Open Men & Women win the Beach Relay finals. I proudly cheered till I had no voice left. The Beach section is always a highlight on finals day.

Currumbin Masters Men and Women also completed their Aussies with some old faces coming out of retirement. There is always a fun vibe had by these competitors and enjoying each other's company with tall tales and beer after makes it a great event. The Masters accumulated ten medals gaining ninety six points.

The Little house (Nippers) stood tall across the road and continued shaking the big clubs up! The overall State titles placed them fourth this season. We look forward to seeing them come across and join the senior ranks. Well done.

The Currumbin Coaching team have worked tirelessly to get the team to reach for their goals and achieve their dreams. Thank you for your patience and commitment. The results are amazing.

It was unfortunate that the Aussies was cancelled and we could debate the for and against, but it is what it is... Currumbin beach Vikings made a mark again placing overall second with only four days of competition. WOW!

Thank you to the Officials, IRB Drivers/Crews, the amazing Team Managers, families and parents who unselfishly give up their time for the Surf Sports Teams to be able to compete. We couldn't do it without you.


