

Presidents Report - Ben Munro

The 2017/2018 season will always, for me, go down in history as one of incredible highs and devastating lows. I am, as always, immensely proud of the way that the members of our great Club handled both extremes. As with all significant moments, I am confident that we now have the opportunity to pull together and collectively move forwards towards a future for the Club which honours those dedicated and magnificent members we have lost.

Let me first highlight the successes. This was another very successful patrolling season for the Club. No lives were lost on our beautiful stretch of beach thanks to the dedication of 274 active beach patrol members who collectively volunteered to provide 6,973.50 patrol hours in order to keep our community safe. This is at the heart of what we do. It is why the Club exists and why it was formed nearly 100 years ago. If all else ceases, this important community service will continue for another 100 years and beyond. I am indebted to each and every one of you for the dedication you have shown towards our first priority. We have such a wealth of talent and experience in the form of Patrol Captains who lead each patrol team with such enthusiasm and pride. Of course, the glue that holds the entire surf lifesaving team together is our brilliant Club Captain, Andrew McIntyre, who this year went above and beyond even his lofty standards, leading with such grace and humility in the face of the loss of the incomparable Annie Owen, as Vice Captain and First Aid Officer. It is always exciting to see a new wave of patrolling members coming through and this season we assisted 53 new Bronze Medallion/SRC Award holders to become qualified. To those newly qualified members I say, welcome to our family.

It was a competitive year to celebrate. We achieved amazing things across every section of the competitive space. The Pool Rescue team were once again crowned Australian Champions after an amazing and dominating performance in Adelaide. The Australian Championships held in Perth saw a modest but very talented team achieve some fantastic results. I am excited by the talent coming through in the younger divisions. However, for me, the highlight of the Aussies was seeing our men's open team take out the Taplin Relay after a hiatus of some 40 years.

For anyone lucky enough to witness this race, it was testament to what I believe we stand for as a Club. There was plenty of talent on display for the other powerhouse Clubs and yet, when it counted, I saw these young men competing for Currumbin simply refuse to yield. We were down and out so many times and yet each team member found something to take the team forward when it seemed there was no more left to give. The celebration at the end of the race is something that I will cherish long after my time as President is finished. That same pride and dedication in the green and white cap is something I saw replicated many times over the weekend in the water and from the beach to the boats. Thank you to Michael King, Tim Peach, Chris Maynard, Joe Fraser (and all of the dedicated boat sweeps) and Kurt Wilson for giving our members opportunities to excel in the sport they love.

Mind you, the senior members were certainly aware that they had a very hard act to follow. The magnificent Currumbin Vikings Nippers took out the Junior State Championships for the first time since the mid-90s. Again, I was on hand to witness lionhearted performances by so many. Some of these nippers had programs which would stop a professional ironman or iron woman in their tracks but, again and again, when asked to give something more for the team and the Club, they did so with guts and determination but also with a huge smile on their faces. My sincere thanks to the Junior President, Ben Cahill and his committee for producing such a talented and invested group of kids. Your committee has made winning fun. Thank you also to the junior coaching team - your wisdom and dedication are material in these successes.

If culture is a commodity, we have it in spades. Thank you to all members, young and old, for the pride and the way in which you each represent the Club we love.

Financially, the Club and the Supporters Association had a very challenging year. By no means is the Club anything but very financially secure. However, we did see a consistent trend across the year of more modest profit margins. In the main, I consider that this is probably a result of some serious competition both from other Surf Clubs who have invested heavily in renovations and also the proliferation of food and beverage outlets in the surrounding suburbs. I can assure you that the Supporters Association is not sitting on its hands. We are deep into preparations for a significant refurbishment of the Club and its facilities, including an IT upgrade. I wish to thank our General Manager, Chris Kelly and his team for the way in which they have doggedly pressed forward despite ongoing challenges and a facility which has fallen behind the competition. Thank you for your patience. We, as a Club and a Supporters Committee, are dedicated to providing you with the facility and the tools to allow you to do what you excel at - providing amazing service in a world-class venue. I am genuinely excited about the year ahead for this business.

CEO Report - Michael Sullivan

Whilst 2017/2018 has presented a number of challenges to us a Club, it has also provided us with the platform to look forward to the future. The restructure of the Club over the past twelve months has laid the perfect foundation for us to not only examine and understand our strengths and weaknesses across all areas of our operations and strategy but also to identify the opportunities that lie in working together with a 'one club' ethos that will no doubt make this great Club stronger than ever in years to come.

This season marked the end of our current strategic plan which I am happy to report has been extremely successful and delivered numerous benefits across the major pillars of our Club back to the members and community. The development of a new strategic plan in 2018 will see us set our strategic priorities for the next five years and beyond presenting some exciting opportunities to reinvest in our assets and our product to ensure our long term financial sustainability and diversity of revenue streams. This won't come without sacrifices however rest assured that all strategic and financial decisions will be made on the foundations of two key premises. That is firstly to ensure we are offering the best services and product to our current members and secondly and most importantly to ensure that we are leaving your Club in a better place for future committees and the next generation of our Viking members.

Our Supporters Club has and always will be a place for our members and the local community to celebrate, socialise and connect. With the planned renovation of the Club in recent seasons, there has been minimal capital investment into the venue over the past few years, so the staff and management should be proud of what they have been able to achieve over the past few years in light of this. The financial performance of our Supporters Club has afforded the Club many opportunities to expand in recent years in all areas of our operations and afforded a wider span of benefits and programs to members than ever possible before. Our staff in the Supporters Club work sixteen hours a day, 364 days a year to ensure funds are available to deliver our surf lifesaving programs and their efforts should be appreciated, recognised and of course celebrated. As a quick snapshot our Supporters Club turned over 217,234 meals to patrons in the last financial year. A big thank you to our Supporters Club Committee, our General Manager, Chris Kelly and the hardworking staff. We are thankful to all members and patrons who frequented the supporters club during the season and supported that side of our operation.

We have seen a successful year on the beach once again achieving our major goal and mission each season of keeping Currumbin Beach safe and fatality free. Over 6973.5 volunteer hours contributed to lifesaving beach patrols and 2684 preventative actions, rescues and first aid treatments. An amazing statistic in itself and one that our members should be proud of. To each and every one of our volunteer members I again thank you for your selfless commitment to our beach operations and lifesaving services. Our Nippers are our future lifesavers and competitors and it is important that we harness the potential that lies in this area of the Club. This season saw the delivery of another hugely successful nipper Sunday beach safety program and as a reflection of the great members we have involved in this space went on to win the Qld State Championship for the first time since 1992. We had another successful surf sports season winning the overall point score at the Australian Pool Rescue Titles and 47 national titles at the respective Australian Championships events. A full list of our surf sport achievements is documented in this report. Well done to everyone who donned the green and white cap this season and to our staff, coaches, managers and officials who made it possible for those members to toe the line.

The Club has been extremely fortunate to have a core group sitting on the management committee for a number of consecutive seasons now. The Council has a great blend of passion for the Club, dedication to their role and the skillsets to perform their job descriptions, ensuring what happens on the beach is delivered in an efficient and effective manner. These members are certainly the unsung heroes of the Club and give many hours on the beach and behind the scenes in the boardroom frequently sacrificing their own personal time and commitments for the greater good of our club and the community. To our Club Council and also to our hardworking office staff and administration thank you for your continued dedication to the club and your roles!

It was also the third consecutive year that our Open men won the beach relay. Our Open Men showed a strong showing across the Individual finals package in all events, and pulled it together with the help of under 19's Ky Kinsela and Joe Engel to bring home the Gold in the Taplin relay. Wow, all six of those boys never gave up and I'm sure there were many prayers sent from above to get them over that line. We last won this event 40 years ago.
