## President's Report - Ben Munro

As we stand at the threshold of our 100th year as a Surf Lifesaving Club, I wonder at the paradox of the junction where our fantastic Club, the iconic Currumbin Beach Vikings, finds itself in Season 2018/2019. It occurs to me that despite the passage of nearly 100 years since we began, the principal character of those who started the lifesaving presence on our pristine stretch of coastline remains the same.

Tragic events contributed to our beginnings. In 1917, a desperate father lost his precious little girl to a rip off the Currumbin Beach. Rather than his heartbreak twisting into blame and recrimination, Mr Fielding Chippendale reached out to the small Currumbin community with a plea that his loss should not be marked without positive change. He asked whether anyone might be willing to form a patrol, dedicated to keeping swimmers safe at this beautiful but dangerous beach. Who could have imagined where the answer to that call for help might have come? Miles away, as Australia was recovering from the horror of the First World War, in the heat and dust of Ipswich, a group of keen, young swimmers had formed the Ipswich Vikings Swimming Club. Each weekend, they endured the many hours of uncomfortable travel to find their way to a little beach adorned with a rock that looked uncannily like an elephant lying down and stretching its trunk to the blue-green waters. These first young Vikings answered Mr Chippendale's prayer for help. Weekend after weekend, they travelled all those miles to and from Ipswich to stand watch to ensure the public could swim and frolic in the waves in safety. If one looks at the faded old photographs that depict these pioneering, young men, instantly you see the pride and joy – and perhaps even a little bit of cheeky irreverence – in those youthful faces. And so began our long and proud tradition of service at The Rock.

From where I sit as President, while the world has undoubtedly changed in the 100 years since, the essence of our Club – and its amazing members – has not. Our youth is as fundamental to our future viability and successes as ever the case in 1919. Our young people must be invested, committed and enthusiastic about lifesaving while thriving in the knowledge that there is nothing better than being a Viking. It is no coincidence that the Club Council has developed a five year Strategic Plan which has Lifesaving and Youth Development as our highest two strategic goals. In my opinion, we live in a world where, within a myriad of competing messages from social media, there has never been a more obsessive focus on self before others. And yet I watch proudly as our young members train hard to achieve their goals, undertake awards to increase their lifesaving skills, attend to raffle in the Club to assist with fundraising and volunteer their time on patrol to continue to keep our beach safe. If one examines the highest patrol hours achieved each year, it is our youth who generally inhabit the top couple of spots on the patrol hours list. My sincere thanks go to the Youth Development Sub Committee who continue to find incredible ways to engage our young members and to teach them about being true Vikings.

The fact is that 76% of our patrolling members are competitive members. It is for these reasons that we have worked hard to develop pathways for our youth to find their point of connection as a Viking. We have a very dynamic Surf Sports program allowing competitors access to the best coaches and programs in the country. External measures of our investment in this program are undeniable. Our achievements this Season include an exhilarating second at the World Lifesaving Championships (by just Ten points!), our second year as Nippers State Champions, our fifth successive Australian Pool Rescue title and, most recently, the naming of Thirteen Vikings in various Australian Surf Lifesaving Teams. As pleasing as these titles are, my overall desire for the program is just to give every single young (and not so young) Viking the opportunity to achieve to the full extent of their potential. That might be winning a National title, but equally, success might be measured by merely making the team and competing with friends. If nothing else, I am confident that our Surf Sports program allows every athlete the chance to know the unique joy that comes from training hard besides Club mates who will become lifelong friends and to know the exhilaration and pride to complete while wearing the green and white colours of our tribe. It is that which bonds water competitors, Beachies, Boaties, Poolies and IRB racers alike. One Team! One Dream! Thanks to our brilliant coaches and to all of the boat sweeps who provide such skill and guidance to our young athletes. Thanks also, of course, to our Director of Surf Sports, Kurt Wilson who drives the program which enables these opportunities for our young people to excel throughout the Season. And, of course, my thanks to the Team Managers and helpers lead incomparably by Marsha Maynard, who "herded the cats", maintained order in the chaos and reminded us all that having fun is the goal!

Our Surf Sports competitors cannot compete unless the Club fulfils its obligations to provide officials and water safety at Carnivals. To the "white shirts" and the "orange vests" who turn up, again and again, to help quietly in the background and away from the limelight, I say thank you. The glory may be on the dais, but the opportunity for that success lies with you! sleep and clock up the miles and put themselves in the poor house to fund craft, you are as much a part of the success of this Season as your kids! I am repeatedly in awe of our Club Captain, Andrew McIntyre, who in his steady, smiling way went above and beyond to ensure we again finished the Season with no lives lost on our beach. It is no easy task to juggle 17 patrol groups populated by a membership as diverse as ours. The reality is that where there were gaps and last minute issues to solve, it was our Club Captain who threw himself into the fray and saved us, again and again. That is leadership! It says this is the way - follow me! With so many young patrollers coming through, what an example to follow! I know history will reveal how fortunate we were to have Andrew with us during these years. My thanks also to our beautiful Vice Captain Brittany Brymer, who herself comes from a proud lifesaving tradition. Britt did an incredible job of juggling her patrolling responsibilities with a very successful season on the beach. And, of course, to the quiet achiever, Carole Walle, who in her efficient, kind way, did an unbelievable job to navigate us through the red tape, the reporting requirements and the resourcing required every week.

Special recognition must go to our Chief Training Officer, Courtney Taylor and Sam Dick for their work this season as our trainers and assessors. These brilliant two young people assisted our members in achieving 75 Bronze Medallion and SRC Awards! That is an increase of 102.5% on last Season. Those numbers are the pride of the State!

While I believe an enthusiastic and invested wave of youth is vital for our long-term success, that resource would be in vain without the guidance, knowledge and care offered by our family of Vikings – and, in some cases, literally generations of them, who continue to contribute in so many ways to our advancement. We are so fortunate to have members whose mighty contributions to the Club over many years – and whose continued passionate, selfless involvement – act as a beacon to those younger members who watch and follow.

Our members and leaders who might be forgiven for believing they have done enough over the years, continue to provide the framework and the glue that so steadfastly binds us together and moves us forward. These are the members who sit on committees and subcommittees, meeting late into the night; who assist by achieving awards which now must be held to allow us to patrol and who alter their arrangements at the last minute to swap patrol hours to allow our young Vikings the chance to represent the Club proudly. A significant reason I contribute my time to this great Club is in honour of those older members who did these things for me when my focus was giving my all to compete for my beloved Vikings. I now gladly return the favour in recognition of the leaders who worked tirelessly to provide my generation of members those opportunities. My thanks to the dedicated men and women of both the Surf Club Management Committee and the Sub-committees and the Supporters Association Committee for the many volunteer hours invested in keeping us moving forward! Without you all, we stop!

Season 2018/2019 has seen a continuation of the financial constriction which has impacted the Gold Coast business sector generally, and the food and beverage industry specifically. As a business model, the Surf Club remains absolutely viable and profitable, but the reality is that an explosion in local competition to our North and South and evolving e-commerce phenomena such as Uber Eats has placed pressure on profit margins.

I can ensure members that both the Surf Club and the Supporters' Association Committees have been proactively moving to bolster the business and to search for new opportunities to differentiate our brand. The Supporters Association has invested heavily in a major refurbishment of the restaurant and bar facilities. A major marketing campaign is in the final stages of planning, and the next phase of works is already being planned. My sincere thanks and utter admiration goes to our General Manager, Chris Kelly, and to all management and staff of the Supporters Association for the dedication to serve our members and the public with a smile and a kind word amid construction, chaos and confusion. I can't wait to see what this amazing team can do with a beautiful new product!

I can also assure members that we have worked hard as a Surf Club to tighten belts and budgets to ensure that expenditure is in all cases responsible and justifiable having regard to the direction of the Club based on the 5 Year Strategic Plan. ## CEO Report - Michael Sullivan

It was another year of growth and success for our great Club. First and foremost the Club again achieved its number one goal and purpose of zero fatalities at Currumbin Beach. In doing so our members contributed 7641 volunteer lifesaving patrol hours across the season with 37 rescues and first aid treatments performed with 2063 further preventative actions undertaken. Thank you to each and every one of our members who volunteered time on weekends and public holidays to assist with beach patrols and make this possible. The Club achieved an overall membership increase of seven per cent this season and an increase of 102.5 per cent in new lifesaving awards gained with 47 new Bronze Medallion and 38 new SRC members joining the patrolling ranks. Our Club trainers and assessors have done a tremendous job this season in up skilling our volunteers and ensuring that our patrol strength continues to meet the needs required to achieve our number one goal as a Club each season.

We had another successful surf sports season, taking out the overall point score at the Australian Pool Rescue Championships for the fifth year in a row and finishing runner up Club on the overall point score at the 2018 Lifesaving World Championships. In addition to this the Club also took out the Qld Board Riding Championships Handicap Point scores to show our depth in surf sports across our multi-faceted programs. A comprehensive list of our surf sport achievements is documented later in this report. Well done to everyone who donned the green and white cap this season and to our staff, coaches, managers and officials who made it possible for those members to chase their goals.

This season saw the delivery of another hugely successful nipper Sunday beach safety program with our nippers and youth members again going on to take out the Qld Youth Surf Life Saving Championships in 2019, defending the title the Club won back in 2018. Our Nippers are our future lifesavers and competitors and it is important that we harness the potential that lies in this area of the Club. Thank you to those subcommittee members, age managers, coaches, volunteers and parents who continue to pave the way and help build our future active members and lifesavers and continue the cycle of the Club.

The Club reinvested in our Supporters Association in 2019 with the licensed venue receiving a major upgrade prior to the end of the 2018/2019 financial Year. Thank you to the members for your patience during this period and to our staff for navigating the works successfully to ensure that we were able to continue trading in a reduced capacity through the undertaking of the works. These works were undertaken to enhance the facilities and service provided by our Supporters Association and I encourage all members to actively promote and get behind our Supporters Association, whose profits are solely used for the purpose of funding the Surf Lifesaving Clubs training and education, lifesaving programs and activities.

The Club continues to look for ways to be financially sustainable with a diversification strategy at the forefront of the latest Strategic Plan. A number of business plans have been tabled and discussed at Club Council and General Meetings throughout the season. The options presented have been targeted at utilising strengths and skillsets already incorporated within our core competencies as a Club through our staff and membership base. With a reduction in Supporters Club operating profit in recent seasons it is now prudent that the Clubs focus be directed in this area to ensure the future viability and sustainability of both clubs moving forward.

The Surf Life Saving Club Council and Supporters Association Management Committee continue to sacrifice their own personal time and commitments in a volunteer capacity for the greater good of our club and the broader community. To our Club Council and Management Committee members thank you for paving the way for the staff and the members and furthermore to our hardworking staff and administration on both sides of the operation thank you for your continued dedication to the club and your roles!

This season the Club welcomed three new proud sponsors on board in Boral, GC Law and Earthfleet. To our official Club sponsors, thank you for your ongoing commitment to the Currumbin Beach Vikings Surf Life Saving Club. We couldn't do what we do without your generous support. Without this support we would simply be unable to deliver our lifesaving, training, education and surf sport programs and activities. To our members, I really do hope that you take the opportunity where it arises to help support our sponsors in return and show our appreciation of the support these generous businesses provide our Club. The Club was fortunate enough to receive a number of grants in season 2018/2019 to assist with upgrading our facilities and delivering our lifesaving programs. Thanks to the Gambling Community Benefit Fund, the Club was able to undertake a facelift and some urgent repairs to the Currumbin Nippers Club. Thanks to Karen Andrews MP, our Nipper Club received funding to upgrade kitchen equipment and thanks to the Gold Coast City Council, DCS Fund and the Beach Safety Equipment Fund the Club was able to purchase an IRB Motor, patrol uniforms and much needed lifesaving equipment to assist with our beach operations and support our annual lifesaving training and education programs.





## Surf Lifesaving

Another season has passed and after 7641 volunteer patrol hours on the beach we have again met our number one Club goal of zero preventable deaths at Currumbin Beach for the season. Our Club Captain Andrew McIntyre was again inspirational, leading from the front both on and off the beach to ensure that we were fully resourced for our lifesaving patrols and able to deliver effective lifesaving services to the 35,000+ visitors to the beach in 2018/2019.

Thank you to our Vice Captain and Patrol Captains for your commitment this season in leading and mentoring your patrol groups. The importance of our Patrol Captains in managing the beach and the position within the club that you hold is greatly respected and appreciated. Thank you to every member who volunteered their time in any capacity throughout the season. A single hour given to community service to ensure our beach remains fatality free is the core existence of our club and future.

A big thankyou to our lifesaving equipment sponsors Bendigo Bank for your continued support and commitment to the local community.

## Training & Education - Courtney Taylor

In season 2018/2019 the focus of the training and education section was to ensure that the patrolling members had the necessary skill set for adherence to the SLSQ Patrol Service Contract. The Committee identified that it was important for the club to provide relevant training opportunities to the members that not only benefit the club but give the members nationally recognised competencies that can be used externally to surf life saving.

One of the key focuses was the standardisation of Emergency care awards to assist with award strengths on patrol. As a result First Aid, CPR and Advanced Resuscitation Technique (ART) courses were introduced as part of the Bronze/Certificate 2 training syllabus. This resulted in a 105.26% increase in ART awards, 133.33% increase in First Aid and 139.13% increase in CPR awards.

This season the Club introduced the Junior Vikings Development Camp, where our Under 14 members attended a day/night camp gaining their First Aid award in an interactive learning environment. Whilst we did not have the numbers we had initially identified, the camp will go ahead again in season 2019/2020 and will target the Under 15 age group also.

There was a decrease in the Beach Management awards gained this season Whilst it is pleasing to see members come forward to become Patrol Captains this is an area that the Club will work in the coming season to ensure we identify future leaders and train them appropriately.

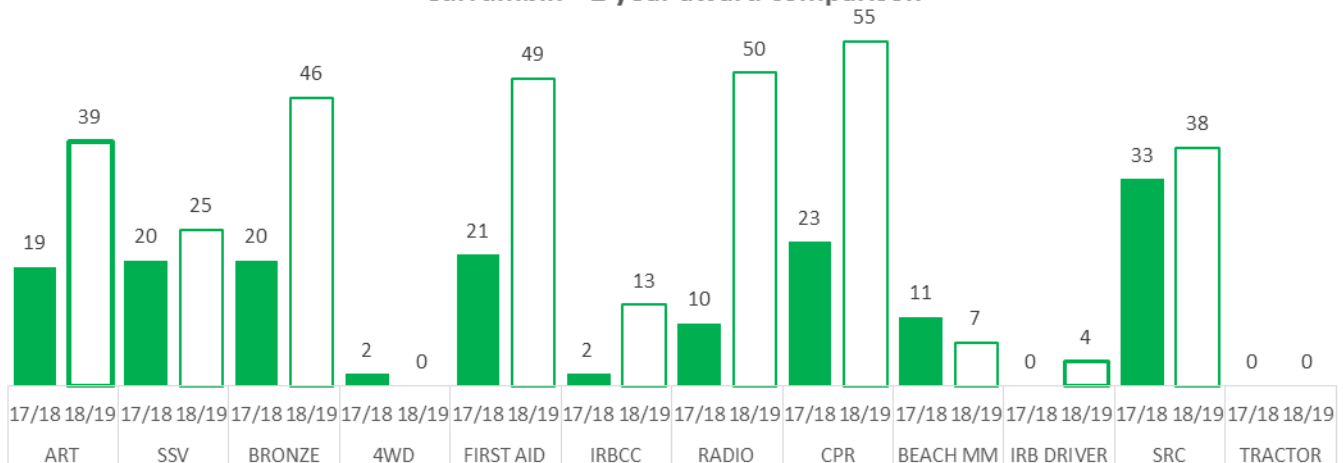
This season we also saw Kurt Wilson gain his Trainers award and working towards his Bronze Medallion trainers, welcome to the Education team Kurt!

As well as growth in the awards mentioned above, it is incredible to see the growth of new recruits and our juniors coming through to gain their Bronze Medallion.

Overall – in the 12 operational patrolling awards Currumbin SLSC posted an increase of 102%. This was the highest growth in Point Danger Branch. A massive congratulations to all members that achieved new awards this season and welcome to our new Bronze and SRC members.

A massive thank you to the Club trainers, assessors and content experts that make up our education team. The achievements in the education section of the Club could not have been achieved without your dedication and commitment. Another key focus of the Club will be identifying future trainers and assessors to assist the club with its ever increasing educational needs.

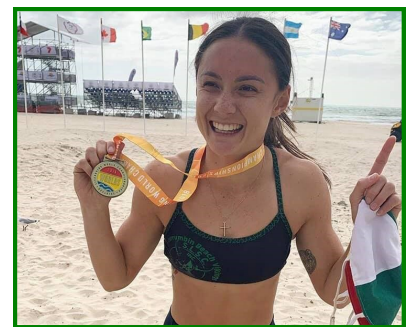
