

The 2020/2021 season has been one of progress and a season that will be very important in the ongoing history of this great Club. I'm pleased to report that over the course of the season the Club once again delivered on its core mission of providing excellence in Surf Life Saving services to Currumbin Beach through our volunteer patrols and our member training and education programs. Our active volunteers delivered 6,322 volunteer hours on the beach to ensure 53,406 beach patrons visiting Currumbin Beach were provided with a safe aquatic environment. Our active members gained 952 new lifesaving awards to provide depth in our lifesaving patrols and ensure we are able to provide well resourced, sustainable and skilled volunteer surf lifesaving patrols into the future. Overall membership numbers increased and our junior membership increased by 21 per cent.

Firstly and most importantly I would like to thank our members for the continued support and patience you have shown throughout the year. Our members are the lifeblood of this Club and without whom we would not exist. The delivery of our programs and the execution of our strategy wouldn't be possible without your collective efforts and the commitment and dedication you selflessly provide to this Club in every aspect of its operation. To each and every one of our volunteers I thank you for your selfless commitment to our beach operations and lifesaving services. The Covid-19 pandemic is arguably the greatest challenge our Clubs have faced. We were buoyed by the enormous amount of support we received from you all both on and off the beach which was comforting for our staff and Club Council who, like many of you, were facing difficult times. While we are not through this pandemic just yet, hopefully (at the time of writing) we are well on our way, and we look forward to seeing our Clubs, services and events operating at full capacity again in the near future.

The redevelopment of this facility has been over 5 years in the making so to see this project become one step closer to reality is exciting for the Club, our nippers and also the Currumbin Community as a whole.

To our official Club sponsors, this last 12 months have not been easy for you either. The strength of a Club is built on the foundations of it's partners and community support. Thank you for your ongoing commitment to the Currumbin Beach Vikings Surf Life Saving Club in these tough times. Your support we simply couldn't do without. # Finance Report Paul O'shea



The audited financial statements of Currumbin Beach Vikings Surf Lifesaving Club Inc for the year ended 30 April 2021 are presented later in this report. I can attest that all expenditure has been made in the best interests of the Club and its members.

The Club's balance sheet is strong with good working capital and provisioned expense balances. This is being maintained by a continued strict focus on current asset and liability management supported by expense minimisation where possible.

Once again, I would like to thank the Club CEO (Michael Sullivan), Administrator (Carole Walle) and accounts administrator(s) (Alana Welch & Vanessa Whan) who were instrumental in assisting with accounts and record keeping throughout the year.

Michael (our CEO), should be singled out for his tireless work on pursuing government grants, this year saw the remarkable feat (and a few years' worth of effort) of securing the State Government's grant of 2 Million dollars to build a new Nipper Club building, all Club members should be tremendously grateful and appreciative of his efforts.

The financial statements highlight the very high cost of running a modern SLSC and our Club cannot survive financially without the generous support of sponsors and a successful Supporters' Club.

I sincerely thank the sponsors of our Club, without their support the club would find it difficult to fulfil its obligations and I hope that all Club members show their full support towards these businesses' that support us. Also, I place on record my appreciation and admiration for the staff and committee of our Supporters Club for their success in achieving a profit in year like no other in our history books.

It has been challenging year for the Club, but we have all managed to pull together to ensure a successful year in comradery, competition wise and as a presence on the beach providing our essential community service.



# Lifesaving Report Andrew McIntyre



While each season brings its own challenges and success, the ability to overcome adversity and succeed rests on the shoulders of those that raise their hand. Our members, have again raised their hand to support the safety of our community, attending 13 incidents, 131 first aid treatments and 499 preventative actions across 53, 406 visitors. On behalf of our Surf Lifesaving Committee, thank you for your commitment, dedication and vigilance in achieving another successful season and ensuring zero preventable deaths on our beach.

The Surf Lifesaving Committee has worked towards improving our administrative processes, communications and patrol equipment. The adoption of Facebook, Microsoft Teams, Zoom and a cloud-based SMS system has greatly improved our ability to communicate, plan and respond to fulfil our core obligations. We have also continued to improve our patrol equipment with the purchase of capital assets including a new IRB, beach SSV, training defibrillators and manikins.

While new equipment is necessary, it is vital that we acknowledge and recognise the contribution of our members. In appreciation for our volunteers, we have introduced the Vikings Recognition Program. This program aims to recognise and celebrate the broad range of ways in which our members contribute towards supporting our club and surf lifesaving. It is pleasing to report, that a number of our members have been nominated for the National Medal through The Australian honours and awards system.

Finally, I wish to thank Pat Trevor-Jones (Vice Club Captain) for his valued support, candour and leadership throughout the year. I would also like to thank our patrol captains and officers, who have outstandingly led the beach and managed their patrol groups and areas of responsibility. Thank you to every member who volunteered their time, gained an award or helped in any capacity when help was needed. Through understanding common goals and shared values, the green and white family is stronger than ever.

# **Training & Education Report** Courtney Taylor



In season 2020/2021 the focus of the training and education section was to ensure that the patrolling members had the necessary skill set for adherence to the SLSQ patrol service contract. The committee identified that it was important for the Club to provide relevant training opportunities to the members that not only benefit the Club but give the members nationally recognised competencies that can be used externally to surf lifesaving. The training calendar was released pre season to assist with gaining these awards.

One of the key focuses was reducing workloads of our trainers by introducing team run Bronze Medallion courses. A massive thank you to all trainers that came on board to assist with running these courses.

2019/20 saw a push in Emergency care awards, making it a hard one to follow. However, even though there was a decrease in First Aid awards gained, we saw a significant increase in Advanced Resuscitation Techniques award gained.

Our dedicated IRB trainers oversaw an increase in IRB awards with incredible feedback from participants on the skill and enjoyment of the courses.

It is a credit to our trainers to see another year of new recruits and our juniors coming through to gain to these awards.

Congratulations to all members that achieved new awards this season and welcome to our new Bronze and SRC members.

Thank you to the Club trainers, assessors and content experts that make up our education team. The achievements in the education section of the Club could not have been achieved without your dedication and commitment. Another key focus of the Club moving forward will be identifying future trainers and assessors to assist the Club with its ever increasing educational needs.

# Supporters Club Report Chris Kelly



Submitting a summary of 2020/2021 is very hard to articulate. I have never in 30 years of hospitality management witnessed its equal.

We started the year with a venue that was closed and 53 staff that had been stood down. Some staff however continued to work throughout this period and special mention should be given to Alana Welch for her unrelenting commitment over this period, as well as the many staff that helped out and volunteered during working bees.

Whilst in the shutdown phase we took the opportunity to complete stage one renovation works that included a complete rewire of the first and second floors, new ceiling, air-conditioning and a new cold room. To complete these works outside of the lockdown would have resulted in extended periods of downtime so through the vision of our management committee we turned one negative into positive.

I would like to thank our valued staff for their effort prior to, during and after our reopening. Countless hours went into our reopen. Covid safe plans had to be developed and adopted, floor layouts adjusted to meet covid safe criteria, development of reduced menu's, introduction of table service, extensive and continued cleaning, additional signage, gaming machine movements, recommencement of accounts and services, and the list goes on. Special mention to Vanessa Whan, Doug Henwood, Stacey Johnson, Tamar Tane & Adam Irwin for their dedication during this time.

We progressed throughout the year from being closed, to reopening with a venue capped at 60, then onto a cap of 120 patrons, onto our current limit (venue capacity) of 240 patrons. With limited income being injected into the business, several expenses and services had to be cut. With no contract cleaning and window cleaning our staff went above and beyond and cleaned the venue each and every day along with many other additional tasks.

However, through the resilience and adaptability of our team we have come out the other side. While we are still not at venue capacity due to covid restrictions, consumer confidence and a lack of international travel, we have remained positive and continue to rebuild on our offer.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank Michael and the Management Committee for their unwavering support once again.

I would also like to thank all of our valued team members for their resilience, adaptability and effort throughout a most turbulent time. They really are second to none and should be commended for their efforts.

I would also like to acknowledge the retirement of Sue Sheppard. Sue's commitment and dedication to the Currumbin Beach Vikings spanned for over 27 years. Sue you are much appreciated by so many and we thank you.

Our members are undoubtedly the foundation of our Club and I thank them for their patience and understanding for the year gone.

We are all looking forward to a less disruptive year in 2021/2022 and are striving to continue rebuilding our great Club.


