Presidents Report

John Brennan OAM



It is an honour and a privilege to present my inaugural report as the President of the Currumbin Beach Vikings Surf Life Saving Club. With over four decades of involvement in Surf Life Saving across all levels within the Association, I am humbled by the opportunity to have led the Club during the 2022/23 Season.

First and foremost, I would like to express my sincere gratitude to all our members who have played a pivotal role in the continued success and growth of our Club. The past 12 months have seen a remarkable surge in our collective efforts, as we have witnessed a tangible and resolute sense of progress.

I would like to acknowledge immediate past President Ben Munro for his 11 year term as President between 2011 and 2022. His exceptional service and unwavering commitment throughout his tenure saw him steer the Club through a myriad of transformations, challenges, and unprecedented growth. His legacy will forever be etched in the Club's history, and we thank him for his steadfast leadership. The foundation laid by Ben and the Club Committees has provided us with a solid platform which we can build on and reach new heights.

I extend my deepest condolences, thoughts and prayers to the grieving families and friends of our cherished members who have tragically lost their lives. May their memory endure as a testament to their impact on our Club, forever etched in our hearts. Below is a summary report on the key areas within the Club:

Club Council

As we embarked on the new season, we introduced the new Club Strategic Plan, laying the foundation for our priorities and the strategies required to achieve them. We have made significant steps in enhancing risk management through the establishment of a Club Risk Management Charter, Workplace Health and Safety Policy, and dedicated subcommittee. Additionally, the implementation of the Members Protection and Compliance Resource has commenced, ensuring the well-being and compliance of our valued members. Our focus on succession planning has begun, and we extend our sincere appreciation to retiring Club Council members for their dedicated service throughout the years.

Lifesaving Services

To our dedicated volunteer surf lifesavers who tirelessly completed 6829.57 beach patrol hours, we thank you for ensuring the safety of all visitors to Currumbin Beach. With a total of 71092 beachgoers, our surf lifesavers conducted 1148 preventative actions, responded to 78 first aid cases, and carried out 4 rescues. The exceptional efforts of our patrol members were reinforced by the addition of 49 new Bronze Medallion and SRC awardees, 46 new First Aiders, 13 ART awardees and 3 new IRB Drivers. Our heartfelt gratitude goes to Club Captain Andrew McIntyre, Vice-Captain Pat Trevor Jones and all the Patrol Captains for their commitment and outstanding service throughout the 2022-23 season.

Membership Development

Our membership base and active patrol base has remained steady in its membership, with a total of 931 Vikings members and approximately 8000 members including Supporters Club. The Membership Services Committee has achieved significant progress in their charter this year, including support for our members attending SLS Youth Leadership and Development Programs and the successful launch of the Valkyrie Vikings female mentor program. The Club's social activities and events have been popular amongst the members, fostering camaraderie and a sense of unity among members creating a cohesive "One Club" culture.

Surf Sports

The Surf Sports division of our Club has shown remarkable growth and success in many disciplines, culminating in a strong display of unity and camaraderie both on and off the beach leading up to and including the Australian Championships in Perth. We received positive feedback on the strength of our Club Culture from other Clubs and officials, which was truly gratifying. Our Mighty Vikings demonstrated exceptional performance in representative teams over the past 12 months, with 14 members being selected in the PDB Rep Team and comprehensive representation in Queensland Cyclone Teams including IRB's (3 Members), Pool Rescue (5 members), Ocean/Beach (7 members), and Surf Boats (5 crews). 14 members achieved representative honours in the Australian Lifesaving Open and Youth Teams, competing in the historic double win at the Lifesaving World Championships in Italy. Nat Peat also represented New Zealand in the Open Team at the World Lifesaving Championships. The 'Hunters' Open Female Surf Boat Crew proudly competed for Australia in the Trans-Tasman Surf Boat Championships in New Zealand securing a magnificent victory. The depth of Currumbin's representation in these teams is a testament to the surf sports program and coaching provided at our Club, encompassing a wide range of surf sports disciplines. We extend our congratulations to all our Vikings who donned the green and white cap and proudly represented our Club, from our youngest Nippers to the legendary Masters.

Junior Activities

Congratulations to the Junior Activities Committee on another great season. Despite facing obstacles due to the rebuilding of the Community Centre/Junior Clubhouse, the JAC exhibited great resilience and successfully delivered an engaging year of Nipper activities. With 308 Nippers registered, it was great to witness the development of our future lifesavers as they gained essential lifesaving and surf sport skills throughout the Summer. The upcoming season holds great excitement as the Juniors prepare to relocate to the new multi-purpose facility, allowing the JAC to introduce a fresh and innovative approach to delivering Nippers on a weekly basis.

Supporters Club

I would like to thank the Supporters Club Committee and Staff for yet another exceptional year. The substantial growth in the Supporters Club business has greatly benefited the Surf Life Saving Club. Currently, the Supporters Club is in the final stages of developing business models for the two new ventures housed in the new Community Centre/Junior Clubhouse. These exciting models encompass the operation of a Café and the management of the Community Centre, which will offer conference facilities, training spaces and corporate rentals. The Café will serve as a thriving business for both members and the wider community, operating seven days a week. Additionally, plans are underway for the establishment of the Coffee Nook on the ground floor of the Surf Club, with progress set for later in the season. Furthermore, in collaboration with the Supporters Club, the Surf Club is embarking on a comprehensive Building Master Plan Review to explore opportunities for modernizing and optimizing our existing Surf Club/ Supporters Club facilities, considering potential growth prospects.

As the 2022/23 season draws to a close, I want to express my gratitude to every member who has played a vital role in upholding our Vikings Values and fulfilling our commitment to serving the Currumbin community. Running a Surf Life Saving Club entails numerous responsibilities, and it is through the collective efforts of our dedicated members that we have successfully managed all the necessary requirements. I would also like to extend my sincere thanks and appreciation to the Surf Club Staff for their dedication and commitment to handling the day-to-day affairs. Your support is greatly valued and appreciated. Looking ahead, I am excited for the upcoming season and the years to come, as I firmly believe that we have not reached our peak but are steadily progressing towards greater heights.



CEO Report

It is a pleasure to present the Currumbin Beach Vikings Surf Life Saving Club Annual Report for 2022/23. I am pleased to acknowledge that as a collective, we delivered and achieved many things across the season.

Our new Strategic Plan, 2023-2027 was launched focusing on the key pillars of developing and recognising our people, internal capability and activity levels, being financially diverse and sustainable into the future and ensuring our safety, governance and risk management standards. We have committed to providing quarterly updates on the progress of our key goals and activities to ensure strategy remains at the forefront of what we do moving forward across our programs and operations.

We commenced the knockdown and rebuild of our Junior Activities Club and Community Centre in August 2022 with the building tracking towards a final completion and handover date of July, 2023. This major project marks an important period in history for both the Club and the Community. The building will not only provide a brand new home for our junior activities members, it will also act as a vital link in connecting our community and the people in it. The QLD Government provided us with vital funding support including a two million dollar contribution towards the project. We were also grateful to secure \$250k in funding from the Gold Coast City Council towards the project, \$35k from the Gambling Community Benefit Fund and \$17k from the Bendigo Bank through its Community Investment Program to bring total funding support pledged to date to \$2.3 million.

In addition to the funding for our major capital works project we also received support from external funding bodies across the season to assist with providing much needed equipment for our beach operations. Thank you to the QFES, BSEF, GCCC and Lifesaving Development Fund for their support across the season.

Our Club sponsors, have continued to grow and we are extremely fortunate to have some great sponsors onboard who help support our members, our great Club and in turn the community. Thank you for your ongoing commitment to the Currumbin Beach Vikings Surf Life Saving Club and your belief in what we do as an organisation.

3 Business Plans were developed and signed off across the season including a Café/Kiosk operation on the bottom floor and events space on the top floor of the Junior Activities Club and Community Centre as well as a Coffee Nook on the ground floor of the main Clubhouse. These plans were endorsed by the Clubs Finance & Investment Committee and Club Council with the recommendation that the business units sit operationally under the structure and commercial activities of our Currumbin Beach Vikings Surf Life Saving Supporters Association. We are actively progressing the business plans within the Junior Activities Club and Community Centre with the goal of opening both businesses in September, 2023.

We welcomed two new staff members this season. Sharon Brennan joined the team in the role of Operations Manager and Anne Stovin joined us in a consultancy role as Business Development Manager to assist with the planning of new business units for the Club and progression of the units to opening. Both have been invaluable additions to the team. We have a great staffing team here at the Vikings including our Club Administrator, Carole Walle, Director of Surf Sport, Kurt Wilson and our coaching team and I wish to offer my sincere thanks and appreciation to our amazing staff group for your unwavering support of myself, the Club and our members.

We remain committed to the protection, welfare and wellbeing of all our members and providing a safe, fun and enjoyable environment for all. In 2022 we rolled out Member Compliance Training to our key stakeholder groups, in addition to developing an internal resource for members. We have taken an inclusive approach to our member compliance program, ensuring all our members are treated with respect and dignity and are protected from discrimination, harassment and abuse regardless of gender, age, ability or nationality.

From a finance & risk perspective a major review of our Capital Asset Management Plan was undertaken in early 2023 to ensure we maintain our fiscal governance standards and financial sustainability moving forward. This season we also engaged an Enterprise Risk Management Company to undertake an operational risk assessment resulting in the formation of the Risk Action Management Plan, development of a master risk register and culminating in the formation of a Risk Management Charter, Risk Management Committee and WHS Charter and Committee to ensure we remain proactive with identifying risk and mitigating risk as an organisation as best as possible.

To our Club Council and Standing Committee members, your support and confidence in our staff through a busy and challenging season is sincerely appreciated by everyone here at the club. You continue to give so generously of your time and skillsets both on the front line and most certainly behind the scenes. Thank you for your dedication and commitment to your roles.

This season sees a number of Committee members depart from their positions after long tenures. After eight years in the role Paul O'Shea will depart the Finance Manager seat this season. Paul has been instrumental in setting up our fiscal governance standards, our finance and investment charters and ensuring that every dollar was always spent in the best interest of the Club and its members.

Ten seasons in any position is an achievement in itself but this season will see Andrew McIntyre put on the red and yellow cap for the final time as Club Captain and Lifesaving Chairperson. This role is one of the most important in the Club given it looks after our number one priority, the lifesaving activities week in week out. Thank you Andrew for ensuring that our number one goal was achieved for the last decade and for the weekends you have personally sacrificed to ensure that our beach operations continued and we met our service agreement obligations.

Our Administration Manager, Marsha Maynard will depart the position after 9 years service on the Club Council across the roles of Surf Sports Team Manager and Administration Manager. Anyone who knows Marsha knows how much she loves the Club and how she bleeds Green and White. Thank you Marsha for everything you have done for us across both roles, many simultaneously.

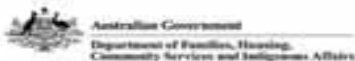

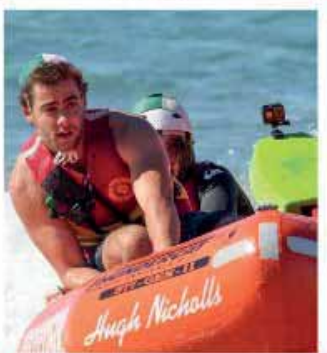

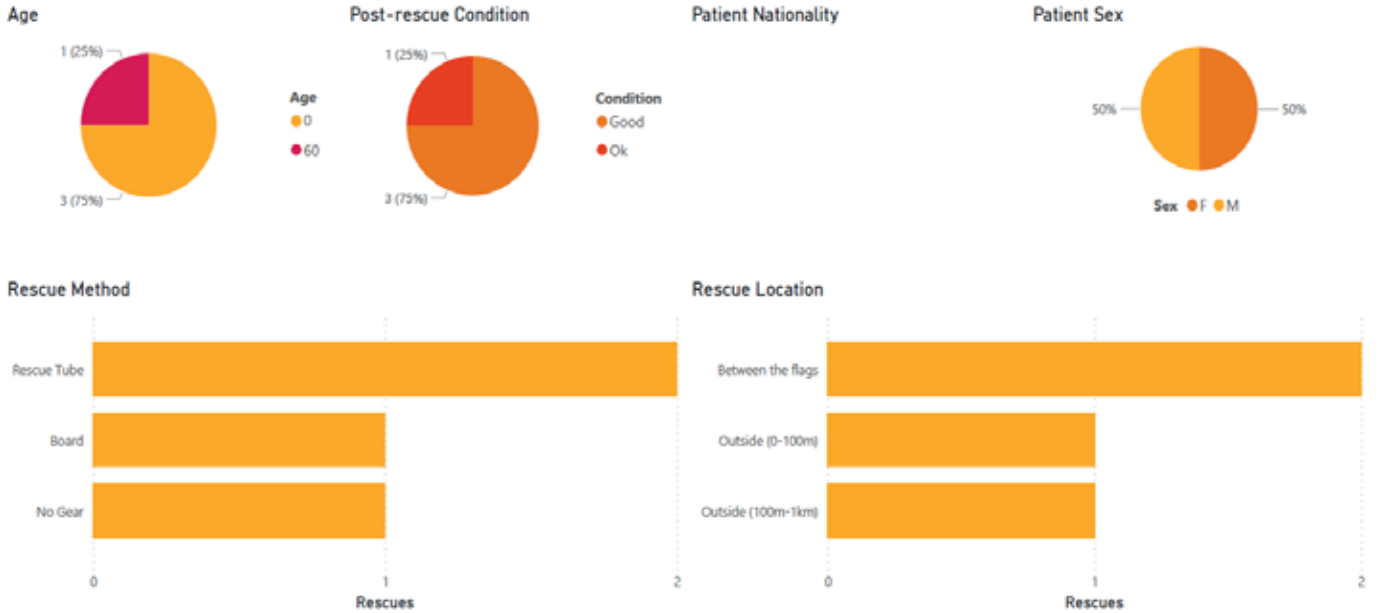

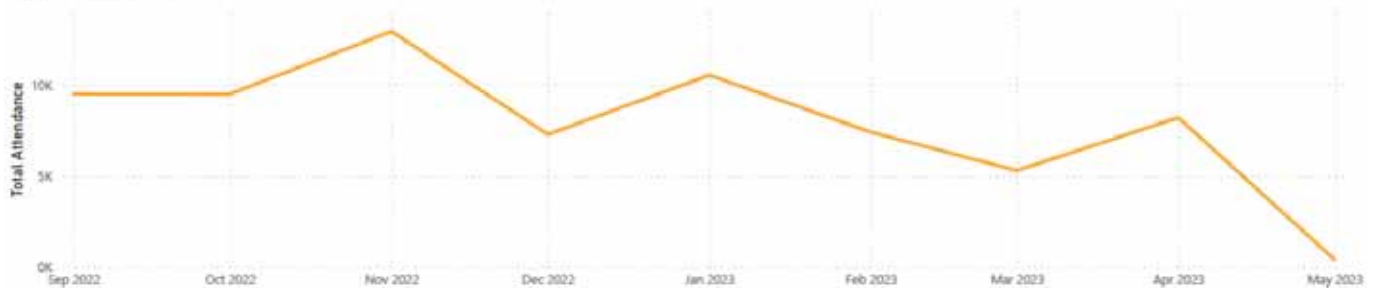

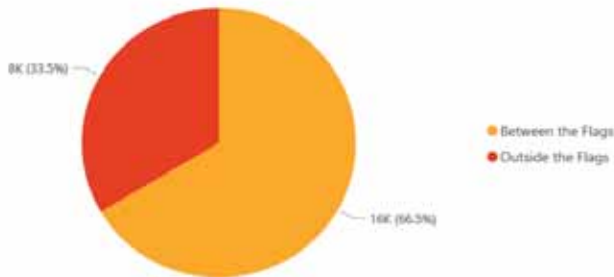

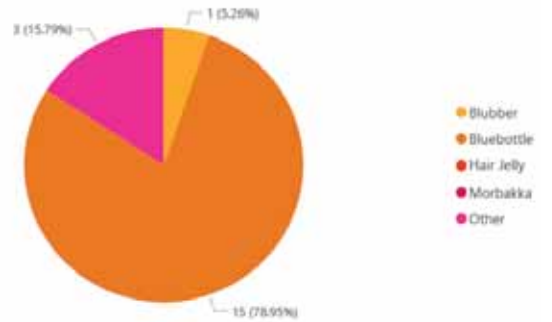

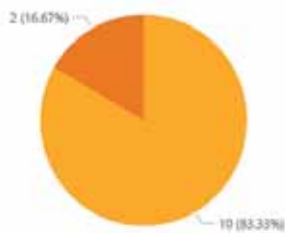

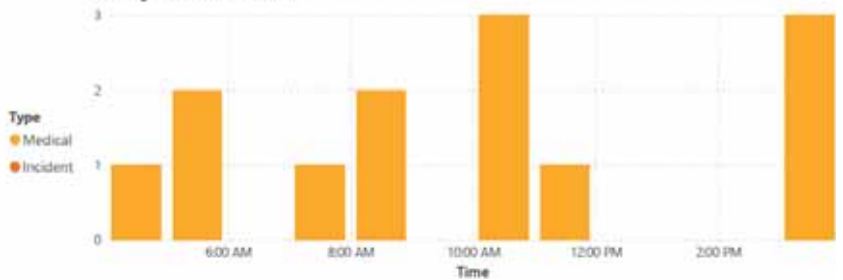

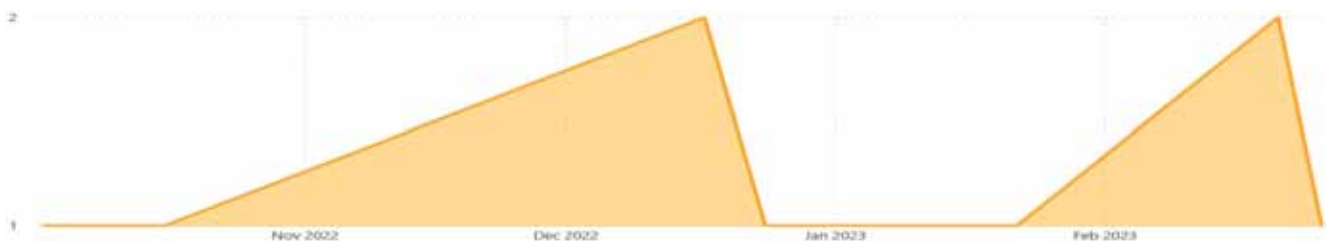
Incidents by Type

For our Training and Education team, the beginning of the 2022/23 season was certainly a busy one. At Currumbin we saw 249 members through their proficiency over the five proficiency days. Thankfully the majority of our proficiencies proved to have favourable conditions with light winds and manageable surf making it all the easier to enjoy another day of lifesaving on Currumbin Beach. These days wouldn't have been a success without our amazing endorsed delegates who volunteered their time, skills and expertise to support our Training and Education team, thank you Sandy Kelly, Ray Fien, Shaun Robertson, Chris Maynard, Michael Chan, Laurie Hallinan, Andrew McIntyre, Michael Sullivan, Ethan Wilson, Tristan Boal, Carole Walle and Maggie Dowker. Thanks also goes to our trainers and assessors who year after year continue to facilitate a variety of different stations on numerous days across the season- your hard work certainly does not go unnoticed.

This season saw 18 new Bronze Medallion holders and 31 new SRC's attain their awards- all these members certainly earned these in some challenging conditions on both assessment and training days throughout September to December. In our Bronze Medallion courses we saw a number of returning members regain their award and also a few new faces joined the Vikings. It was fantastic to see our returning members supporting our new members through the challenges that Currumbin Beach had to offer in the form of rough seas. A special thanks to Steven Cahill for all his efforts with the SRC groups. Both SRC courses produced high quality new patrolling members as a result of Spider's hard work and dedication in teaching these SRC's all they need to know to be capable lifesavers.

For the 2022/23 season, the Training and Education Committee has welcomed ten new trainers who are near the end of their course and ready to commence their journeys as a Currumbin probationary trainer. Congratulations to Paul O'Shea, Tai Smith, Ty Buckmaster, Herb Winter, Darcy Winter, Frankie Fisher, Clay Youngkin, Rio Heaney, Celeste Nutley and Jacob Loughnan. These members will provide invaluable experience and support to the role in training our newest Bronze, SRC and IRB members.

I wanted to start the 2022/2023 report with a quote which I believe encompasses what we are at Currumbin Beach Surf Lifesaving Club from our volunteers, loyal membership, sponsors, and supporters to dedicated and professional coaching cohort and Club Council who were so supportive of our surf sports section.

With being a community Club, we would not survive if it wasn't for the generosity of members who give up their time and commit to club committees, become team managers, water safety personnel and officiate at the various carnivals around the South East of Queensland. To those members I say a big thank you.

Our athletes are extremely lucky to have the coaching cohort they do, Kurt Wilson, Rachele King, Zane Holmes and Sam Dick, are some of the best in the business. Our sweeps Lyle Clark, Matthew Wildman, David Dwight, Glenn Williams, Steve Purcell, Brett Dowker Wil McDowell, Billy Psaltis, and Paul Davies have done an outstanding job in maintaining the high standards the boat section set for themselves. The connection the coaches and sweeps have with their athletes goes a long way to explain why our athletes have achieved this season.

The season kicked off way back in July with our IRB and Pool Rescue sections winning bucket loads of medals at their respective Queensland State Championships, this culminated with the Pool Rescue crew winning over 50 medals at the Australian Titles. This year the Australian IRB Titles were down on the south coast of NSW, a small team competed and were rewarded for their efforts with winning the Clubs first Australian medal, a bronze in the under 23 Tube Rescue. The team consisted of Nathan Gordon, Herb Winter, and Tai Smith. Whilst most athletes were back into the surf, we had several athletes preparing to represent Australia and New Zealand at the World Lifesaving Championships in Italy with some outstanding results under the guidance of Kurt Wilson (Head Coach), Rachele King and Sam Dick (both Assistant Youth Coaches). I'd like to congratulate Ben Carberry (Opens), Rachel Eddy (Opens), Prue Davies (Opens), Elizabeth Forsyth (Opens), Natalie Peat (Opens New Zealand), Callum Brennan, Ryan Green, and Riley Brennan (all Youth). While our Salties were busy going about their work our boaties were warming up for the season ahead, with many crews this season the boat section was led well by David Dwight and the results achieved were fantastic. The highlights of the Harbingers winning Ocean Thunder, Cockatoos winning the ASRL Open, the Hunters (being selected to represent Australia) doing the double at State and Aussies and the Chilli Pepperz going back-to-back at Aussies, our multiple podium winners across several events at Titles along with the five crews who got the opportunity to represent the state was outstanding.

Aussies in Perth was dubbed the "Mighty Mighty Vikings Voyage", and what a voyage it was. One hundred and fifty Vikings made the trip west and our presence was clearly visible for the ten days of competition from youth to masters and opens. With the tone set by our evergreen masters our open competitors started their raid with our Surf Rescue section leading the way with podium finishes and culminated in a Saturday to remember with both our Lifesaver Relay teams coming second and third respectively and EJ Forsyth winning a record fifth Australian title..

"On Saturday afternoon our Club culture was showcased in the most organic and authentic way imaginable.. without any formal communication 150+ Vikings gravitated to the beach front amphitheatre to support our beachies.. our Viking clan intent on being apart of what might unfold, hopeful of witnessing something special and dedicated to supporting our beach queen EJ as she embarked on winning her fifth straight Australian Beach Flags Title, all sections of the Club were packed in and clapped, screamed and bellowed loudly... our famous phrase echoing as one Club, all feeling proud that our barracking and cheering might just make the difference! As EJ's lifelong friends and lifelong Club mates Sam, Tim, and Mat literally stood in her corner holding towels, drink bottles, ice and red-bull and with a contingent of 150 strong vikings howling the amphitheatre roof off, EJ won Gold and etched her name in the record books earning her own slice of surf sports history... of course she did! What no one saw coming however was the sheer beauty of 150 vikings chanting her name in unison "EJ" "EJ" "EJ" bellowing and echoing across the foreshore that was fuelled by pride, passion and admiration.. we were part of something bigger than ourselves, we were part of history, we were part of greatness!! In this moment, it dawned on me that "Culture" eats cash for breakfast everyday of the week, the currency we trade in at Currumbin can't be converted, it can't be brought, it can't be sold and it never runs out when your a Viking, it's an unlimited line of credit and Vikings spend up large in whatever our endeavour."

I believe we are in a position of opportunity as highlighted by Ryan Green after winning the U19 Taplin Relay, "Currumbin are coming, so you had better look out".

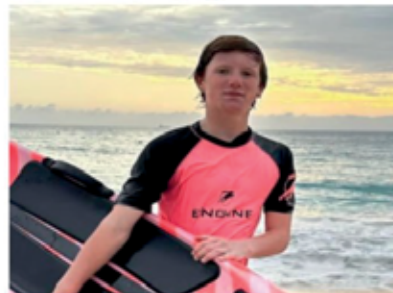

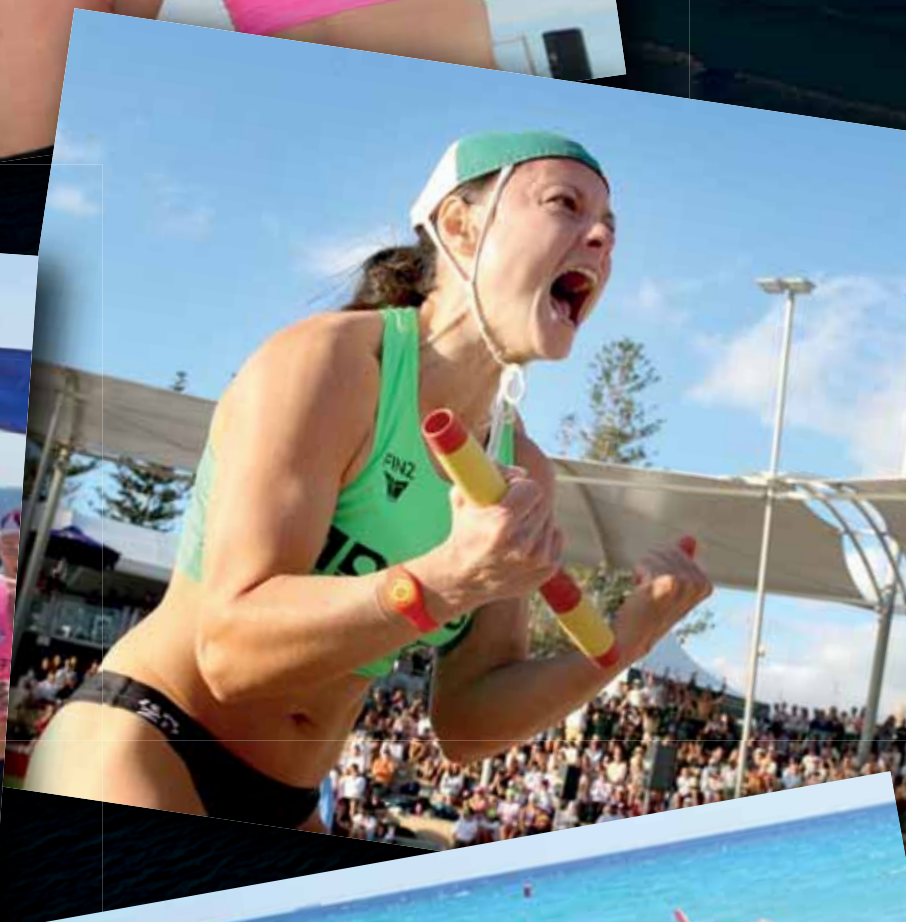
