Background:

This policy has been written and revised in conjunction with Curumbin SLSC's SRC Patrol Policy Statement.

Purpose:

The policy has been developed in order to clarify SRC Award holders membership obligations to both Surf Lifesaving Patrols and Nipper Activity Days

The Policy is in line with the Clubs strategy to foster and encourage youth members engagement in both surf lifesaving activities and surf sport activities and offer pathways for both areas

Scope;

- Under the existing Curumbin SLSC lifesaving policy SRC Members are not obliged to attend all rostered patrols until they gain their Bronze Medallion award
- Should an SRC Members rostered patrol day fall on a Nipper Activity Day then the member may choose whether they wish to attend either their rostered patrol or the Nipper Activity Day
- Providing they hold an SRC Award the member may choose to either participate in a Nipper Activity Day or complete a Voluntary Patrol
- At the Patrol Captains discretion an SRC member may be asked to provide Water Safety for a Nipper Activity Day should this be deemed necessary to fulfil water safety obligations
