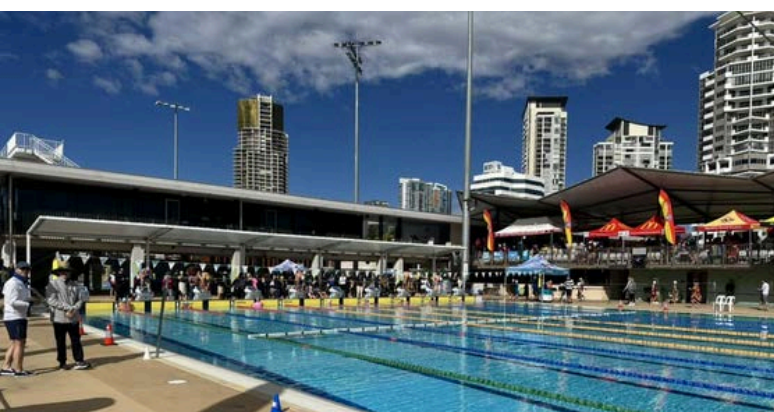

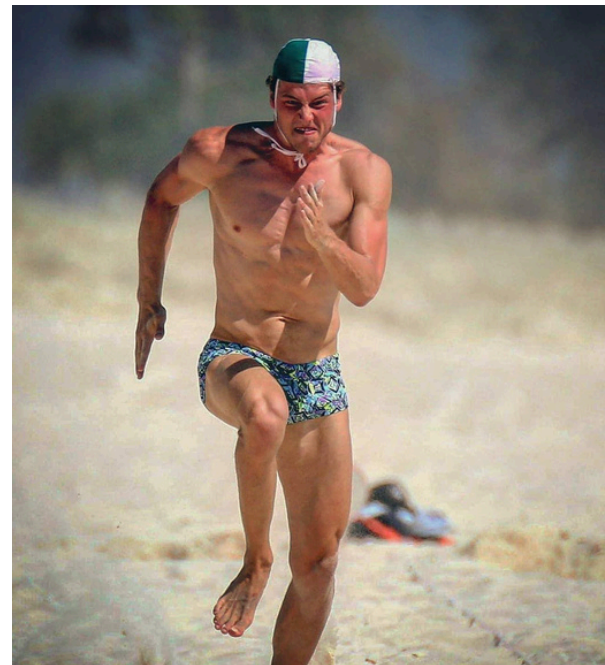

Rachelle will be supported in the senior section by Hayden White and Jayden Erskine, with Sammy Dick coaching the beach and flag athletes.

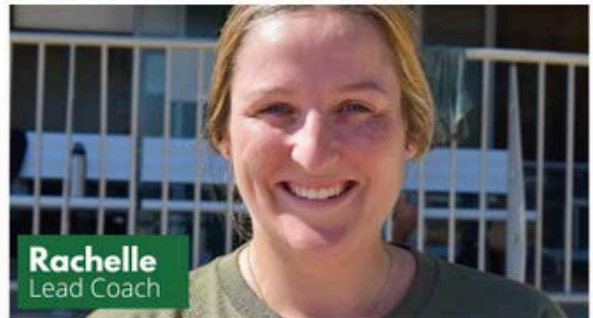
Our Junior and Youth coaches, Zane Holmes and Dan Norton Smith, will once again lead our talented Juniors and Youth.
